

Angels in the Bible: all references...

Genesis 19:1 The two **angels** arrived at Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gateway of the city. When he saw them, he got up to meet them and bowed down with his face to the ground.

Genesis 19:15 With the coming of dawn, the **angels** urged Lot, saying, “Hurry! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away when the city is punished.”

Genesis 28:12 He had a dream in which he saw a stairway resting on the earth, with its top reaching to heaven, and the **angels** of God were ascending and descending on it.

Genesis 32:1 Jacob also went on his way, and the **angels** of God met him.

Job 1:6 One day the **angels** came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came with them.

Job 2:1 On another day the **angels** came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came with them to present himself before him.

Job 4:18 If God places no trust in his servants, if he charges his **angels** with error,

Job 38:7 while the morning stars sang together and all the **angels** shouted for joy?

Psalms 8:5 You have made them a little lower than the **angels** and crowned them with glory and honor.

Psalms 78:25 Human beings ate the bread of **angels**; he sent them all the food they could eat.

Psalms 78:49 He unleashed against them his hot anger, his wrath, indignation and hostility— a band of destroying **angels**.

Psalms 91:11 For he will command his **angels** concerning you to guard you in all your ways;

Psalms 103:20 Praise the LORD, you his **angels**, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word.

Psalms 148:2 Praise him, all his **angels**; praise him, all his heavenly hosts.

Matthew 4:6 “If you are the Son of God,” he said, “throw yourself down. For it is written: “He will command his **angels** concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.”

Matthew 4:11 Then the devil left him, and **angels** came and attended him.

Matthew 13:39 and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are **angels**.

Matthew 13:41 The Son of Man will send out his **angels**, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil.

Matthew 13:49 This is how it will be at the end of the age. The **angels** will come and separate the wicked from the righteous.

Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his **angels**, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done.

Matthew 18:10 "See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that their **angels** in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven.

Matthew 22:30 At the resurrection people will neither marry nor be given in marriage; they will be like the **angels** in heaven.

Matthew 24:31 And he will send his **angels** with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

Matthew 24:36 "But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the **angels** in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Matthew 25:31 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the **angels** with him, he will sit on his glorious throne.

Matthew 25:41 "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his **angels**

Matthew 26:53 Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of **angels**?

Mark 1:13 and he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. He was with the wild animals, and **angels** attended him.

Mark 8:38 If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy **angels**."

Mark 12:25 When the dead rise, they will neither marry nor be given in marriage; they will be like the **angels** in heaven.

Mark 13:27 And he will send his **angels** and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of the heavens.

Mark 13:32 "But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the **angels** in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Luke 2:15 When the **angels** had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

Luke 4:10 For it is written: "He will command his **angels** concerning you to guard you carefully;

Luke 9:26 Whoever is ashamed of me and my words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy **angels**.

Luke 12:8 “I tell you, whoever publicly acknowledges me before others, the Son of Man will also acknowledge before the **angels** of God.

Luke 12:9 But whoever disowns me before others will be disowned before the **angels** of God.

Luke 15:10 In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the **angels** of God over one sinner who repents.”

Luke 16:22 “The time came when the beggar died and the **angels** carried him to Abraham’s side. The rich man also died and was buried.

Luke 20:36 and they can no longer die; for they are like the **angels**. They are God’s children, since they are children of the resurrection.

Luke 24:23 but didn’t find his body. They came and told us that they had seen a vision of **angels**, who said he was alive.

John 1:51 He then added, “Very truly I tell you, you will see ‘heaven open, and the **angels** of God ascending and descending on’ the Son of Man.”

John 20:12 and saw two **angels** in white, seated where Jesus’ body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot.

Acts 7:53 you who have received the law that was given through **angels** but have not obeyed it.”

Acts 23:8 (The Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, and that there are neither **angels** nor spirits, but the Pharisees believe all these things.)

Romans 8:38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither **angels** nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers,

1 Corinthians 4:9 For it seems to me that God has put us apostles on display at the end of the procession, like those condemned to die in the arena. We have been made a spectacle to the whole universe, to **angels** as well as to human beings.

1 Corinthians 6:3 Do you not know that we will judge **angels**? How much more the things of this life!

1 Corinthians 11:10 It is for this reason that a woman ought to have authority over her own head, because of the **angels**.

1 Corinthians 13:1 If I speak in the tongues of men or of **angels**, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal.

Galatians 3:19 Why, then, was the law given at all? It was added because of transgressions until the Seed to whom the promise referred had come. The law was given through **angels** and entrusted to a mediator.

Colossians 2:18 Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of **angels** disqualify you. Such a person also goes into great detail about what they have seen; they are puffed up with idle notions by their unspiritual mind.

2 Thessalonians 1:7 and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful **angels**.

1 Timothy 3:16 Beyond all question, the mystery from which true godliness springs is great: He appeared in the flesh, was vindicated by the Spirit, was seen by **angels**, was preached among the nations, was believed on in the world, was taken up in glory.

1 Timothy 5:21 I charge you, in the sight of God and Christ Jesus and the elect **angels**, to keep these instructions without partiality, and to do nothing out of favouritism.

Hebrews 1:4 So he became as much superior to the **angels** as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.

Hebrews 1:5 For to which of the **angels** did God ever say, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father"? Or again, "I will be his Father, and he will be my Son"?

Hebrews 1:6 And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's **angels** worship him."

Hebrews 1:7 In speaking of the **angels** he says, "He makes his **angels** spirits, and his servants flames of fire."

Hebrews 1:13 To which of the **angels** did God ever say, "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet"?

Hebrews 1:14 Are not all **angels** ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?

Hebrews 2:2 For since the message spoken through **angels** was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment,

Hebrews 2:5 It is not to **angels** that he has subjected the world to come, about which we are speaking.

Hebrews 2:7 You made them a little lower than the **angels**; you crowned them with glory and honour.

Hebrews 2:9 But we do see Jesus, who was made lower than the **angels** for a little while, now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

Hebrews 2:16 For surely it is not **angels** he helps, but Abraham's descendants.

Hebrews 12:22 But you have come to Mount Zion, to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem. You have come to thousands upon thousands of **angels** in joyful assembly,

Hebrews 13:2 Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to **angels** without knowing it.

1 Peter 1:12 It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves but you, when they spoke of the things that have now been told you by those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven. Even **angels** long to look into these things.

1 Peter 3:22 who has gone into heaven and is at God's right hand—with **angels**, authorities and powers in submission to him.

2 Peter 2:4 For if God did not spare **angels** when they sinned, but sent them to hell, putting them in chains of darkness to be held for judgment;

2 Peter 2:11 yet even **angels**, although they are stronger and more powerful, do not heap abuse on such beings when bringing judgment on them from the Lord.

Jude 1:6 And the **angels** who did not keep their positions of authority but abandoned their proper dwelling—these he has kept in darkness, bound with everlasting chains for judgment on the great Day.

Revelation 1:20 The mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand and of the seven golden lampstands is this: The seven stars are the **angels** of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Revelation 3:5 The one who is victorious will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his **angels**.

Revelation 5:11 Then I looked and heard the voice of many **angels**, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders.

Revelation 7:1 After this I saw four **angels** standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth to prevent any wind from blowing on the land or on the sea or on any tree.

Revelation 7:2 Then I saw another angel coming up from the east, having the seal of the living God. He called out in a loud voice to the four **angels** who had been given power to harm the land and the sea:

Revelation 7:11 All the **angels** were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshipped God,

Revelation 8:2 And I saw the seven **angels** who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

Revelation 8:6 Then the seven **angels** who had the seven trumpets prepared to sound them.

Revelation 8:13 As I watched, I heard an eagle that was flying in midair call out in a loud voice: “Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three **angels!**”

Revelation 9:14 It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, “Release the four **angels** who are bound at the great river Euphrates.”

Revelation 9:15 And the four **angels** who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind.

Revelation 12:7 Then war broke out in heaven. Michael and his **angels** fought against the dragon, and the dragon and his **angels** fought back.

Revelation 12:9 The great dragon was hurled down—that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray. He was hurled to the earth, and his **angels** with him.

Revelation 14:6 Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth—to every nation, tribe, language and people.

Revelation 14:10 they, too, will drink the wine of God’s fury, which has been poured full strength into the cup of his wrath. They will be tormented with burning sulfur in the presence of the holy **angels** and of the Lamb.

Revelation 15:1 I saw in heaven another great and marvelous sign: seven **angels** with the seven last plagues—last, because with them God’s wrath is complete

Revelation 15:6 Out of the temple came the seven **angels** with the seven plagues. They were dressed in clean, shining linen and wore golden sashes around their chests.

Revelation 15:7 Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven **angels** seven golden bowls filled with the wrath of God, who lives for ever and ever.

Revelation 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the temple until the seven plagues of the seven **angels** were completed.

Revelation 16:1 Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven **angels**, “Go, pour out the seven bowls of God’s wrath on the earth.”

Revelation 17:1 One of the seven **angels** who had the seven bowls came and said to me, “Come, I will show you the punishment of the great prostitute, who sits by many waters.

Revelation 21:9 One of the seven **angels** who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and said to me, “Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.”

Revelation 21:12 It had a great, high wall with twelve gates, and with twelve **angels** at the gates. On the gates were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel.
